Our Year 6-10 boys had a fantastic excursion with Mr Hartley and Mr Whytcross. You can see more pictures on our school Facebook page.




Extra Extra

Proud and Deadly Awards



Students will also need to bring money for entry to the pool if they don't have a season ticket.


