PSSA Tennis Knockout – Round 4

Last Wednesday 20 July the combined JRAP schools tennis team consisting of Jane Haeusler (BCS), Mae Lucas (ACS), Jack Hawthorn (ACS) and Zac Dart (APCS) travelled to Griffith to play Hay Public School in Round 4 of the PSSA tennis knockout.

Despite having to replace the wet balls every set due to the courts being a little spongy underneath, all students played extremely well, displaying excellent sportsmanship. Jane played excellent tennis and was too strong for her opponent, winning her singles match 6-0. She then teamed up with Mae in the girls doubles, also resulting in a 6-0 score line. Jane and Jack combined well in the mixed doubles winning 6-1. It was a dominant day for the girls with Mae also winning her singles match convincingly 6-1. Jane was complimented by the opposing team manager for her excellent quality of tennis.

The boys singles competition was much more competitive with both matches being very close including many long rallies and games. Jack played some quality tennis and despite getting off to an early lead, lost 3-6 in a set with many long rallies. Zac also played well in a hard fought match, winning 6-4. Jack and Zac then teamed up in the doubles, however despite having many long rallies, were unable to capitalise on major points losing 1-6. WEDNESDAY Week 5 in the Library

Commencing at 9:15am

Students will bring home a list of words to study for homework. It is suggested that students focus on ten to twenty words each week and review difficult words.

Possible strategies for learning words include:

- 1. Break the word into syllables or sound groups and put a slash between each syllable or a button dot under each sound you can hear in the word.*
- 2. Underline small words in the large word.*
- 3. Circle letter patterns.*
- 4. Draw shape boxes around the letters in the word.*
- 5. Use spelling rules for adding ing, ed, ies, es, s etc.*
- 6. Think about how the word is built? Does it have a base word, a prefix or a suffix? Is it a compound word or a homophone?*

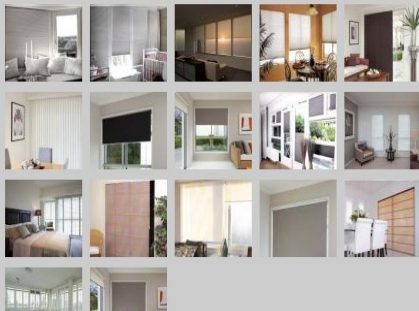
