Review and Re-write



Each day, during study hall or after school, go through the notes from that day. Re-write them and highlight, underline, or circle the key points.



Make Study Cards

At the end of each week, make study cards of the important things you learned in each class for that week, and briefly quiz yourself on them. This way, when it gets closer to test time, you will not be in a rush to make study cards for the entire unit.



Find a Quiet Study Area



Whether you prefer the library, or a shady spot under a tree, find a place where you will not be distracted while you study. Avoid studying in bed, or on a couch, where you may be tempted to take a nap.

Take Breaks

Set a timer for 30-45 minutes, and study non-stop for that length of time. When the timer goes off, take a 5-10 minute break before returning to studying. Every 3-4 hours, take a 30 minute break to eat, drink, or take a quick walk.

Term 4 Intensive Swimming Program

With the pool now open it won't take long for our swimming program to begin. This may include PE lessons for Secondary and Primary students during class time.

In Weeks 8 and 9 this term, we will be conducting our usual Intensive Swim classes with the following times:
Period 1 and 2 - Primary (including all of Mrs Campbell's class)

Between recess and lunch - Infants (Only K/1)

After lunch - Secondary

Secondary students not involved in the program, either after lunch or helping with the other 2 groups, will be having normal classes.

A list of the levels for each student is on the notice board outside the staffroom. Most have progressed a level but some still need to work on the skills they learnt in 2016. If you have any questions about groups, etc, please contact me.

The cost will be the same as normal pool entry, \$2 per lesson unless you have a season ticket. It is important that ALL clothing and swimmers be marked with the student's name and that 'extras' like old clothes for some levels are organised prior to commencing the program.

If weather doesn't allow us to swim then normal classes will run. If in doubt, presume swimming will take place please.
