



Men's Health Education Rural Van (MHERV) is out and about in rural NSW.

MHREV's job is to shine a light into the future for rural blokes. With a few simple tests, shining light may reflect green, amber or bright red! Just about anything that the MHERV tests show can be easily treated by a local family doctor. But if it's an amber or red light it may need to be soon.

It's a five minute non-invasive group of tests:

- blood sugar, just to heart isn't too stressed
- Blood sugar levels just a pin prick in the finger, to make sure there's no type two diabetes, which is manageable even if there is
- Cholesterol another pin prick to see if levels are high and need attention
- There's also a bowel test for cancer we'll provide the kit but that needs to be done later at home

In the past MHERV has shown us a bright red light and lives have been saved. A health check with MHERV is completely free, it is a community service sponsored by Rotary. Contact Community Health Centre for more details.
