#### The Cranky Tooth Fairy

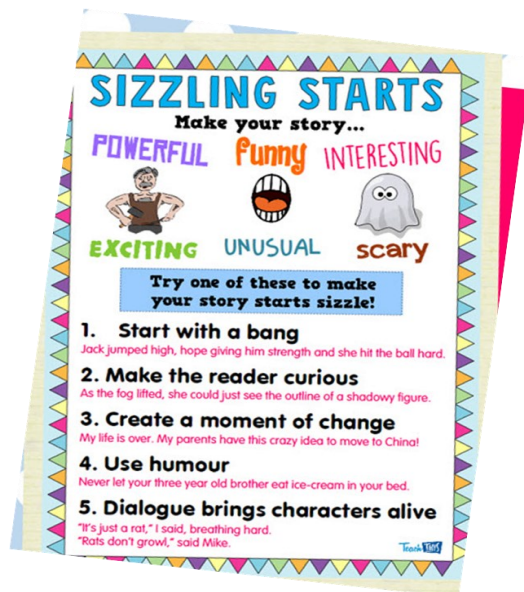
*Once there was a Tooth Fairy with a bad temper. She always went out and ...*
