REGIONAL STEM AVC CHALLENGE

On Friday 19th of May the Riverina Access Partnership STEM students participated in the regional finals of the Aeronautical Velocity Challenge held at Griffith High School. The competition features a series of events where students design and build a range of planes and rockets and compete against other schools in a range of categories. The RAP team consisted of Luke Evans (BCS), Kokulan Kandeepan (BCS) and Sullivan Walker (APCS) who competed in the Junior Skylap category. Here students were given 45 minutes to collaboratively build a balsa wood plane that could compete against other Riverina School's entries in Height, Speed and Dog fight battle. The RAP team have spent most of Term 1 working on prototypes in the STEM elective at Barellan Central School, and the team were well equipped and prepared to replicate/build their competition plane in the allocated build time. The first competition was the Speed challenge, and whilst posting decent times in their first 2 heats, they were 1.8 seconds off Griffith High School's plane and came a very respectable third.

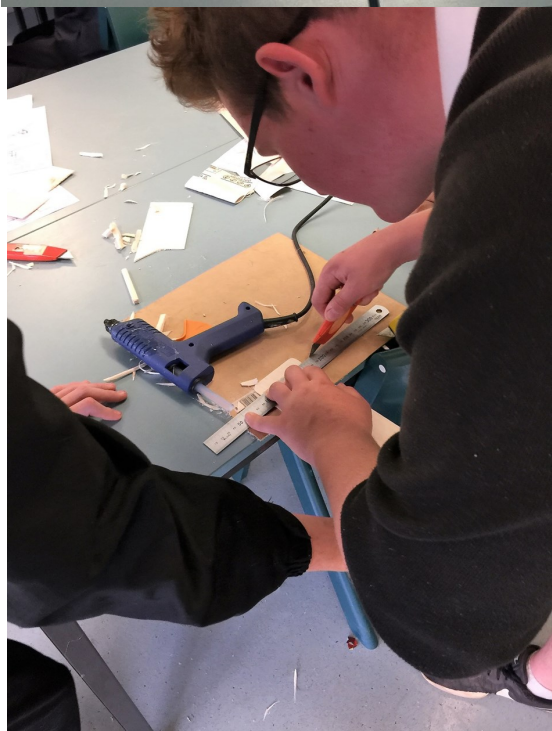
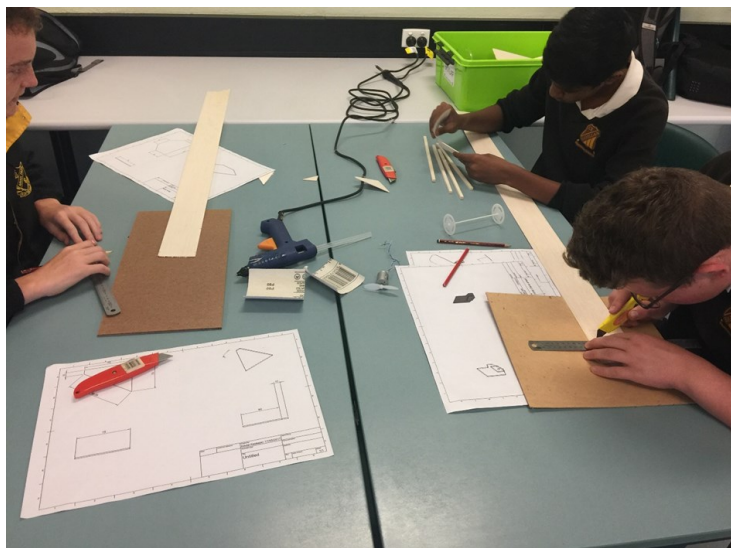
The next category was the height challenge, and the team used a 15 minute rebuild window to make several changes to their fuselage, wings and stabiliser. The changes paid off, with the redesigned plane setting a new Personal Best for the team, and clear winner in the category on the day. The team grew a lot in confidence from this win, and charged into the final Dog Fight/ Battle category with their 'Drop In' strategy which proved to be too good for the other competitors on the day and finished in this category in equal first place with Wagga Wagga Christian College.

The team will now have the opportunity to compete in Wollongong at the NSW State finals in Week 7 and the students will spend the lead up refining their plane and strategy in hope of being crowned the NSW state champions!
