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Principal's Report

To start this report I would like to thank the community, students and staff who have helped cradle one another through a difficult week. Whilst we feel deeply the losses, we have ensured that we maintain as normal as possible a routine for all staff and students.

School entrance and memorial bench.

Due to the rains last week, laying the concrete was set back and has delayed the work on the upgrade to the school entrance. We still anticipate the work being completed by the end of next week (23 November).

School Student Leaderships Team

We now have in place the 4 executive members of the student leadership team for 2019, Senior School Captains Chelsea Gordon and Isabella Smith, and junior school captains Sophie Male and Dakota Smith. Students will be selecting their representatives on Wednesday when the prospective SRC members speak to their respective teams sharing their vision.

Attendance clarification

Regular attendance at school is critical for learning. From time to time, we send letters home reminding parents to provide an explanation for absences. These letters are just friendly reminders to justify absences from school. I would also like to clarify that in our recording system there are a number of classifications of absences. When a student is absent, we only report to parents if an absence is explained or unexplained. As a school, we also need to record if an absence is justified or unjustified. A justified absence includes attending a medical appointment, illness or attending a significant family event such as a wedding. An example of an unjustified absence would be to engage in part-time work out of school hours or helping at home taking care of a younger sibling. Once absences that are unjustified, even if they are explained, hit a certain percentage, then the Home School Liaison Officer will become involved to assist with improving attendance at school. The bottom line is simply that attendance is important, and we as a school and system of Public Education want to support students to attend school.

Gazette schedule in 2019

As with anything in schools, when we shift our energy in one area, we move it away from another area. For example, if a teacher spends all their time marking student homework, then they will spend less time preparing engaging lessons. In looking at the time spent by our staff preparing the Gazette,

I don't see a justified outcome from the productivity expended on a weekly newsletter. In term 1, 2019 we will be shifting to a newsletter every two weeks. This will enable us to better allocate community liaison time more effectively into directly engaging with families and planning for learning pathways for individual students.

Progressive Assessment Tests

We are currently exploring progressive assessment testing for all of our students K-10. This is not supposed to be a stressful event for any students, and we certainly do not want them to be anxious about them at all. It will consist of students sitting a range of tests on spelling, reading, grammar and punctuation, science and mathematics. K-1 will be doing different testing, looking at early years reading and mathematics. The information provided by this testing is important for us to measure the impact of our learning experiences and to assist teachers for 2019 to plan learning experiences that are better tailored to your child. Students should not be studying for these tests, and they should not be concerned about them. The testing platform we are using is through ACER, and we will share the individual reports from the testing with parents when reports are published at the end of the year.
