YEAR 12 FUNDRAISER

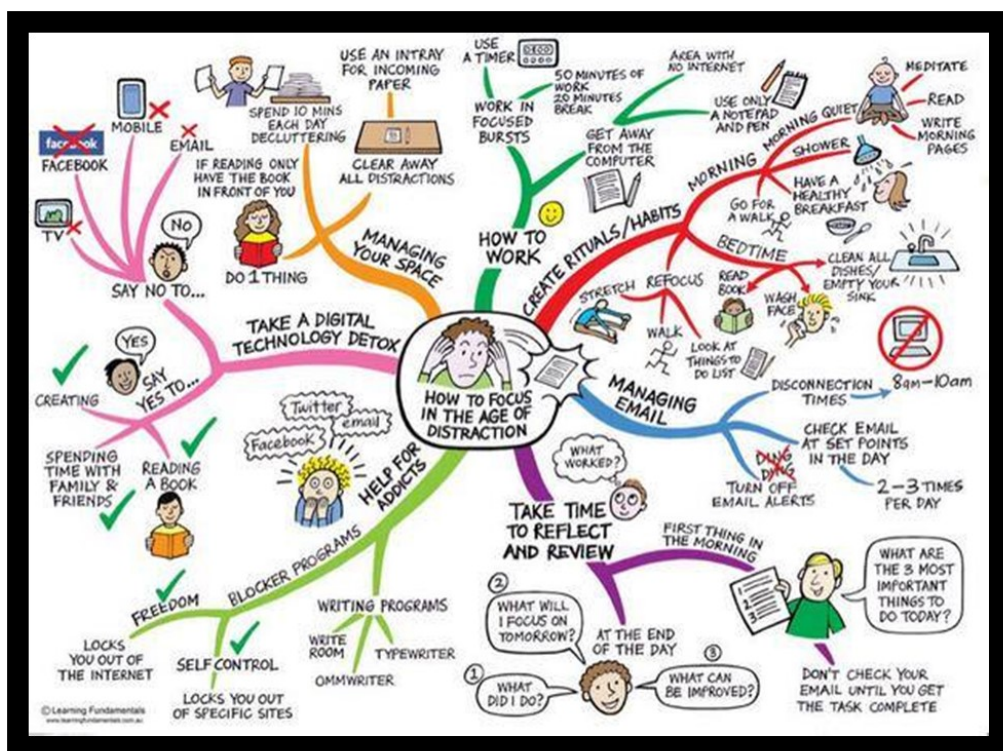
