PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Hello, I'd like to start by introducing myself. My name is Paul Laing and I'm the new principal. My background is in teaching French, Spanish and Geography and I've taught in both the city and the country. My previous role was working with the Department of Education at the Griffith Education Office as a Curriculum Advisor and Teacher Quality Advisor, and my last school role as the Deputy Principal at Yanco Agricultural High School.

I would like to extend a warm welcome to Robyn Locke who comes to us in a newly created position at the school this year as a Learning and Support Teacher. Robyn comes from Leeton High School where she has been working for 5 years, and has a wealth of experience in both Primary and Secondary schooling. Robyn will be assisting us in developing teachers' capacity to cater to individual student's needs, as well as a whole range of roles such as supporting special provisions and student learning.

In my limited time here so far I can see that the excellent reputation of the school is justified. I have been impressed by the students' willingness to engage in conversation as I wandered through the school at the end of last term, as well as seeing plenty of happy and friendly faces. I have also been pleased by the level of professionalism of the teaching staff in sustaining deep conversations around improving the

learning of every student, and the genuine concern expressed by the support staff across the school, all with the best interests of the students at the heart of what we do. It is an honour to be leading such a dedicated and caring team. Whilst students remained at home on day 1 of the term, teachers were engaged in a number of different activities. As a whole school, we examined the significance of literacy to students' lifelong outcomes. This is the beginning of a sustained focus on improving learning across the school, which is also embedded into the school plan for the next three years.

Research is clear that better student learning and wellbeing outcomes are achieved through an active partnership between the school and families. On a personal level, I would certainly benefit from getting to know you, the parents better, including your expectations and hopes for your children. Intention to apply for Year 5 entry to an opportunity class in 2019

Dear Parent/Carer

Opportunity classes cater for highly achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These classes help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for opportunity class placement are considered mainly on the combined results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test and school assessments. The Opportunity Class Placement Test will be held on **Wednesday 1 August 2018**.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2019, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from **Tuesday 1 May 2018** at <https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-5>. The application web-site opens on **Tuesday 1 May 2018** and closes on **Friday 18 May 2018**. No late applications will be accepted.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after **1 May 2018**.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

Remember: The tear-off strip below is not an application and the school cannot apply on your behalf.

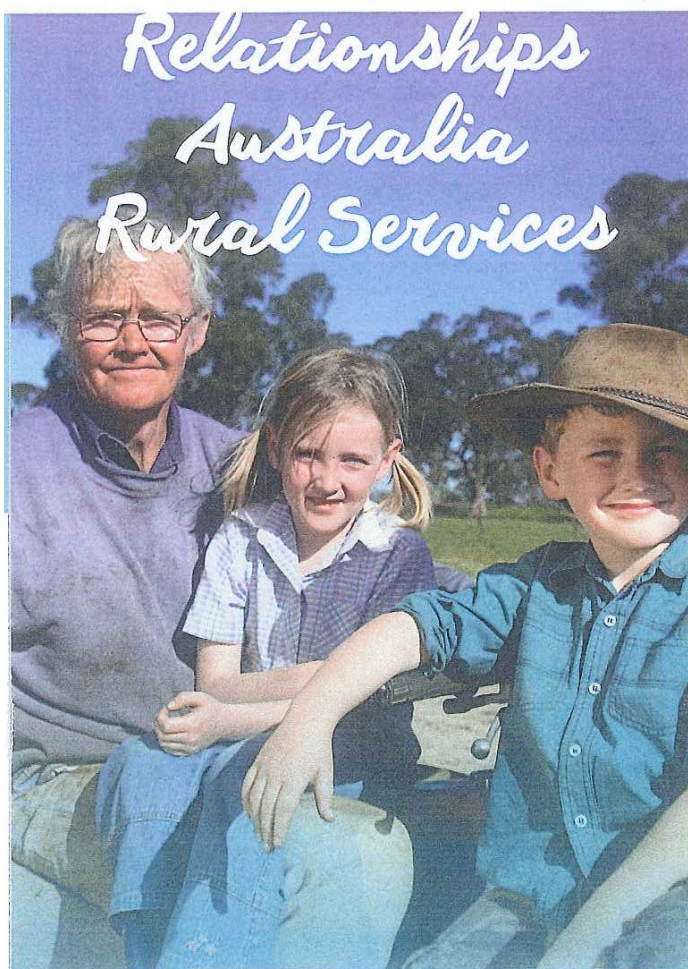
