Staff meeting on cognitive load

You've probably experienced cognitive overload when you try to do too many things at one time, like cooking, talking on the phone, telling the kids off and following a recipe. An interesting one to notice is that when you are walking along talking about something interesting, you'll slow down or stop walking. These are signs that you are becoming cognitively overloaded. Cognitive load has important implications for learning in the classroom, and there are lots of strategies to help students learn.

Teachers have been developing and using different strategies to assist students with managing their cognitive load to improve their learning. This afternoon all teachers will be presenting on their learning to each other, and evaluating the impact of these strategies. You may begin to notice some small changes to your child's learning, this will be in response to teachers trying different strategies to improve learning. We are all about life-long learning for all members of our community.

Start next term

The first day of next term will be a staff development day. These days are critical for the learning of our staff. All teaching staff will be involved in a combined day-long workshop on Highly Effective Teaching practice, and all administrative staff will be involved in a network meeting at Ardlethan CS. Students' first day will be Tuesday 24th July.
