PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

End of term

As Term 2 comes to an end, I would like to extend my appreciation to the students, parents, and staff for their warm welcome of me. It has been a whirlwind of a term, and I have always believed that Term 2 is the most difficult one as a teacher. In this term, we have made numerous achievements as a school. Notably we have:

- Engaged in a broad range of professional learning experiences for staff.
- Developed an Anti-bullying plan in consultation with the P&C, SRC and teachers.
- Learnt about literacy and the importance of literacy in improving students' life outcomes.
- Run the athletics carnival, and hosted two zone athletics carnivals.
- Developed a Learning and Support Team.
- Refined teachers' performance and development plans.

These are just a small sample of whole school events that cross my mind, but other highlights for me include:

- Meeting with the SRC to discuss their plans for improving student wellbeing.
- Discussing with a group of primary students their creations in the kitchen.
- Listening as students share their creations for science week, such as crafting circuits and testing buoyancy
- Seeing the joy on students' faces as they sit silently reading around the playground after lunch.
- Discussing with year 9 and 10 students their views of the school.
- Students avidly sharing their achievements like coming up with a plan to plough the Ag plot and change the paddocks.

The list can go on and on. Daily I see happy students doing wonderful things with their teachers.

Anti-bullying plan

Today, all students will engage in an afternoon session where we will work through a number of activities about the nature of bullying, and explaining how students and parents can report bullying. An important starting point is developing a shared understanding that bullying involves behaviours that are:

- deliberate
- repeated
- hurt a specific person
- an abuse of power

Other behaviours, like not sharing or being rude on a one off occasion, are still unacceptable, but they are not bullying.

These unacceptable behaviours will be dealt with under the normal behaviour management processes.

Tomorrow afternoon we will be tabling the completed draft of the Anti-bullying plan to parents. The SRC will be running the sausage sizzle between the two sessions, so please come early and grab a sausage, or stick around and have a chat with a sausage at the end of the first session.

That's why the Return and Earn container deposit scheme is rolling out statewide from 1 December 2017. You'll be able to do your bit for the environment by returning eligible containers for a 10c refund at hundreds of collection points across NSW.

ELIGIBLE DRINK CONTAINERS

Most 150-millilitre to 3-litre drink containers are refundable if they are made from:

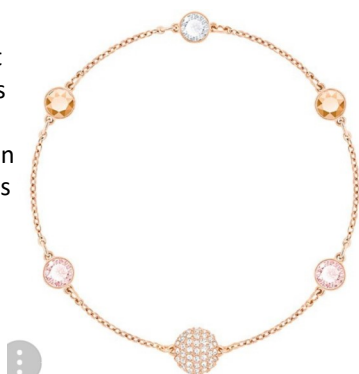
- Glass
- Plastic
- Aluminium
- Steel
- Liquid paperboard (cartons)

Wine, spirits, cordial and plain milk containers are generally NOT eligible. Containers should be empty, uncrushed, unbroken and have the original label attached. If a container is not eligible for a refund, please use a recycling bin.
