## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

### Parent teacher evening/ afternoon.

Parent teacher interviews will take place on 6 August from 3:30-6:00PM. In order to make the interviews, please follow the instructions below. If you prefer to call the school to make the appointment, please feel free to do so directly on: 6963 9202.

### Instructions

1. Please go to the website  
<https://www.schoolinterviews.com.au/>
  2. Select MAKE A BOOKING at the top right.
  3. Enter the code **ffkve** in the "Enter code ..." box
  4. Enter your email, full name, the number of children (students) for whom you are booking interviews and the child's (student's) name(s). Then select GO.
  5. Select the class or subject for which you would like an interview, then the teacher in the second box.
  6. Select 'go'
  7. You can then select the times you would like. Generally, please select a
    - a. 5 minute long interview in secondary,
    - b. 10 minute one in primary.
- If you anticipate that you will need longer than 10 minutes, please contact the school to make a longer interview on another day.
8. Once you have made all of your choices, select 'go'
  9. You will see a summary of your bookings which will also be emailed to you (the email you enter at the beginning). Select 'finished' to log out of the system.

### School Uniform Policy

The NSW Department of Education has revised the School Uniform Policy and associated guidelines following an extensive review and consultation process, including with the NSW Parents and Citizens Association. The revised School Uniform Policy requirements include that:

- all students have the opportunity to access the full range of school activities, including physical activities while wearing a school uniform
- girls must have the option to wear shorts and pants
- consideration is given to cost and how to assist families, including for schools to inform parents how they can access financial support to purchase school uniform items.

Where changes are required to a school's uniform, there must be formal consultation with students, teachers and other staff, parents or carers, and the school community (including the Parents and Citizens' Association). Parents and carers should be given up to 3 years to comply with any changes. For queries please contact me directly at the school. I will also table this at the P&C on Tuesday evening for brief conversation.
