Principal's Report

Planning for 2024

Planning is well underway for 2024 with many exciting developments. I'm happy to share the teaching structure for primary classes for 2024. Please understand that the student numbers are based on current and anticipated enrolments, and should only be understood in a general sense. K/1/2 – Mr Jack McDougall (anticipated 15 students)

3/4 – Mrs Kirstie Overall and Mrs Jenna Woodland (anticipated 14 students) 5/6 – Mr William Cummins (anticipated 13 students)

Secondary classes have not been finalised, however we will continue to run with stage based classes (a year 7/8 class and a year 9/10 class).

Focus for 2024

The school is entering in to a new planning cycle (2024-2027) and we are completing a situational analysis, which effectively means taking stock of where we are currently sitting. We will be surveying parents and the community early in the new year regarding this analysis before finalising our plan by the end of term 1 next year.

Current emerging focus areas include:

- developing deeper knowledge for all students
- explicit teaching practices
- tailored support for all students to experience success.
