Principal's Report

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you have all had an enjoyable holiday season with family and friends and that the New Year has started off nicely for you. We look forward to working with you in partnership when supporting your Child's educational, social and emotional development throughout 2023. We are so glad to see so many happy faces returning to school and settling into a new year of learning. A particular welcome to all the new families who are starting off with us this year.

Staffing

We welcome two new members of staff to the wonderful team here at Barellan Central School for 2023. We congratulate and welcome Mr Jack McDougall who will be teaching the K/1/2 class and Ms Kerri Daly who is the new Assistant Principal Learning & Support for our network of schools. Although Kerri is based here, her role sees her travelling and supporting multiple schools in providing direct and timely assistance to students with additional learning and support needs and their teachers.

Uniform Focus

The school positively encourages students to wear full school uniform as it promotes a sense of belonging for all students. We have started the year off with the students looking fantastic in their full school uniform.

Regular Attendance at School

Both Australian and international research shows that regular attendance helps students to;

Supporting positive school attendance is a shared responsibility – everyone has a role to play. Thank you to all parents / carers for informing the school when you know your child is going to be absent so that absences can be marked as explained rather than unjustified.

Back to School Vouchers

Many families may have heard by now that late last year the Government announced a \$150 'Back to School Voucher' for all students enrolled in School or Home Schooling. We have sent an information letter out earlier this week to all families indicating how to obtain the voucher and the eligible purchases that you can use the voucher for. Since then, there has been another update (announced on Tuesday) that these vouchers can now be used to pay school fees if families wish. We are currently investigating a 'Scan & Redeem' system at BCS for this. More to follow on this soon.

Staff Development Days

As mentioned in previous reports, the staff at BCS put a lot of time and effort in their planning and preparation for the term ahead to benefit the learning opportunities for all students. I'm happy to report that we collectively enjoyed the two days in our teaching teams discussing, planning and preparing for the term ahead. I would like to thank all staff for their professionalism and participation in the Staff Development Days.

Evacuation Procedure / Drill soon

As it is the start of a new year and we have new students and staff here at BCS, we thought it would be a good idea to practice an evacuation drill. It is something all schools need to do at least twice a year to remain familiar with the procedures in the event of an emergency evacuation. Please note, that we will be doing an evacuation drill during week 3 (next week). I write this to inform you there is no need for panic if you hear an alarm signalling from the school. There is no need to attend the school thinking something is wrong. We will also notify families closer to the day via Facebook. Please rest assured if there ever was a real emergency evacuation, families would be contacted if needed.
